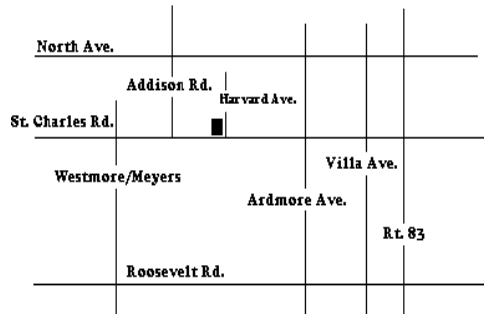

## AN AWANA OVERVIEW

At Awana, the focus growth in our individual Christian walks. This is a time for discipling, equipping, and challenging our 3 year olds through 6th graders to a deeper walk with Jesus and to step out in boldness for the cause of Christ. All grades will be working on the appropriate books from Awana. In addition to that, there are the specific teaching curriculums for each grade where we share with the students the truths of God's Word. We also have an exciting time of games, stories and music.



Cubbies: 3-5 year olds that are potty trained. At Story Time each week, preschoolers learn about God – the greatness of His love and His Word – and about His Son, Jesus Christ, the promised Savior. Games and crafts build excitement and reinforce Story Time lesson themes.



Sparks: Kindergarten-2nd Grade

Kindergarten—Book 1: Who is God?

During the year, your child will look at the attributes of God. As they learn about who God is, they will also learn how this affects them today!

1st & 2nd Grade—Book 2 & 3: God at work in the Bible. Over the course of two years, your child will look at the Bible to see how God was planning from the beginning to have Jesus be our Redeemer and Savior!



Truth & Training or T&T: 3rd-6th Grade
